



NOTICE:

In accordance with Grayson County Fiscal Court Ordinance 150.0 there is an imposed transient room tax of three (3%) percent on the rent of every occupancy of a room(s) accommodating guests in such a way as an inn or similar accommodation for a consecutive period or thirty (30) days or less in Grayson County, Kentucky. This tax is collected from the consumer by the collecting agent and is used to fund the operation of the Grayson County Tourist Commission. Collections from the agents by the Fiscal Court occur on a quarterly basis and must be paid no later than thirty (30) days following the month in which said taxes were to have been collected. Each collecting agent must file a return in duplicate on a form which is provided each quarter. The Grayson County Fiscal Court is authorized to take all appropriate action to provide for the collection and enforcement of these taxes. The failure to properly complete and return the provided reporting form each quarter shall be subject to appropriate civil and/or criminal remedies provided by the Commonwealth of Kentucky and Ordinance 150.0.
